Environmental art templates for slot together, animal sculpture.

Materials: To construct the sculptures you can use any stout recycled paper or card Can including recycled cereal box card, thick cartridge paper, thin card, grey board, corrugated cardboard etc.

Sculptures can be decorated using any recycled materials including newspaper/magazine collage, fabric, confectionary/crisp wrappers, paint, ink etc

Equipment: scissors, craft knife, cutting mat PVA glue,

These slot together, templates are photocopyable and can be enlarged to suit the appropriate available materials, e.g., Recycled thick, cartridge paper, thin card, cereal box card, grey board and corrugated card.

N/B The scale and thickness of materials will have to be considered when cutting the slots. The thicker the materials the wider the slot needs to be cut.
